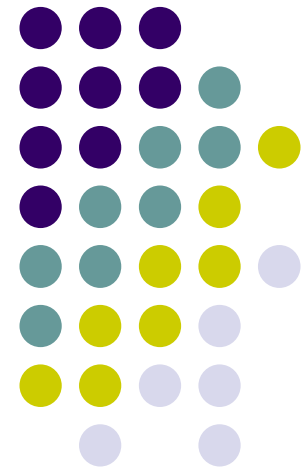

Lab reagents (606) lists in comparison with (640) lists in 2006.

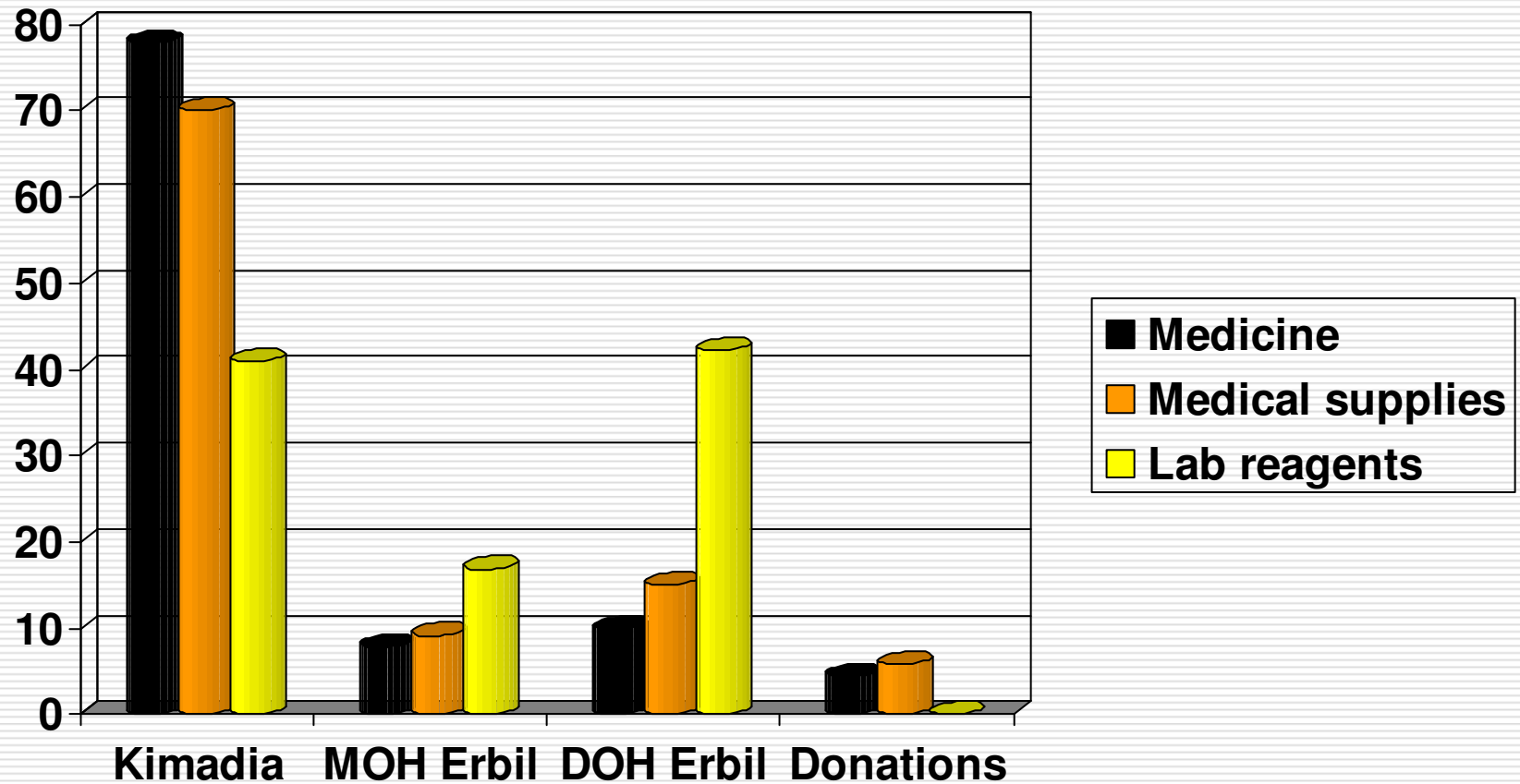

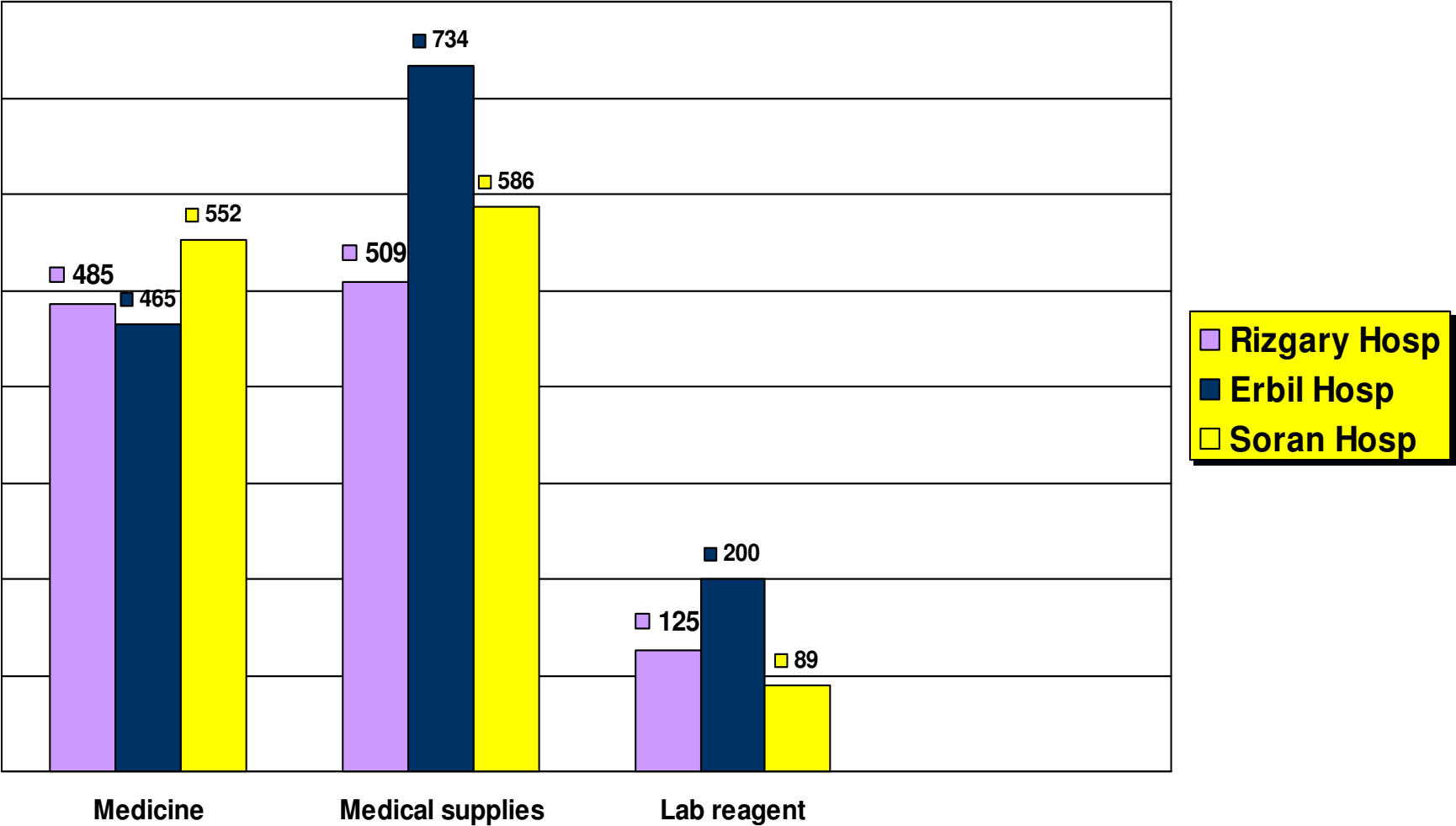

Remarks

Allocation a specific budget by MOF for “medicines, medical supplies, medical equipments & Lab reagents” purchasing from the local market had a great effect on improving our capacity and ability to cover Hospitals and PHCs needs.

Communication and coordination with Kimadia has been improved, but still they do not have capacity to cover DOH Erbil needs even with emergency items.

Bulk supplies from Kimadia is large but did not meet DOH Erbil needs on the base on needed items.

Recommendations

1. Upgrading & development of Micro drug software for Medicine administration.
 2. Training for Pharmacists, Warehouse keepers and labors on Warehouse management.
 3. Pharmacists play more responsible and active role at Health districts & Hospitals in coordination & joint activities with the department.

Recommendations

4. Construction of new Warehouse compound with international standards.
 5. Importation of medicines, medical supplies and Lab reagents through direct contract with the manufactures in order to ensure the quality especially in the absent of Quality Control System, this is also to control the quality of MOH Baghdad bulk supplies.

Recommendations

- ❑ Medicines, medical supplies, medical equipments & Lab reagents purchasing directly from local market must be based on the MOH standard list of registered companies (manufacturers, distributors).
 - ❑ Providing incentives for the staff.
